

## **SAM: Tricks of the Trade with New IOLs**

Selection of an appropriate IOL is a critical decision for any patient undergoing cataract surgery and, due to advances in technology over the past decade, many more options are now available.

This Self-Assessment Module reviews a number of factors that should be considered when helping patients with presbyopia and astigmatism decide if a premium IOL is the right choice. Special considerations for patients with corneal surface disease and post-LASIK patients are also reviewed.
